There was some talk recently about [Blue Obelisk](#) software available as [Ubuntu](#) / [Debian](#) packages. This morning I had trouble waking up, so hacked up a [metapackage](#), so that you can now do:

```
sudo add-apt-repository ppa:egonw  
sudo aptitude install blueobelisk
```
