Some time ago, the brilliant [GitHub](#) people gave me the following tip. Rajarshi is [lazy](#), and might find it interesting. By appending `.patch` to the commit URL, a commit can easily be downloaded as patch. That way, developers can easily download it with `wget` or `curl` and apply it locally with `git am`, without having to fetch the full repository.
